- Please do NOT print, hand write/sign forms or use DocuSign or AdobeSign. This removes the digital completion components.
   Download and save as an Adobe PDF document. Open with *Adobe Acrobat* to complete forms. Do not fill out forms in browser or Mac Preview.
- Adobe Acrobat Reader is available for free at the Adobe website
- All faculty need to sign using Adobe Verified Signatures on the same form. (Follow in-app prompts to set up faculty signature.)

Doctoral Research Appointment or Reappointment applicants must complete both the DRE and Graduate Faculty application sections. Send the electronic (not scanned) Application, CV, and the first page of three (3) written products (or verification of artistic performances) that have been peer-reviewed within the last five (5) years (For written publications that have been accepted for publication but have not yet appeared in print, an acceptance letter must be supplied) to your Chair or School Director. They will send the package to the College Dean, who will then forward to the Graduate School. The Graduate School will process for the Standards Committee of the Graduate Council review.
