## Explanation of Enrollment Data

1. The Spring Final date is June 4, 2014. Data included in this report is information captured from the Banner Enterprise Data Warehouse (EDW).
2. Percent Change in this report is the measure of change from Spring Final 2013 to Spring Final 2014 as a percentage. Caution: When considering % change, it is important to note that increases or decreases in categories with low numbers will result in a high percentage change.
3. Due to rounding, some graphs may not total 100%.
4. Urban Education students are included in Main Campus.
5. Colorado School of Public Health students are not included in this summary.
6. Funding Summary:
  - a. Headcount: Students counted in Extended Campus have only cash funded courses
  - b. Credit Hours: Main Campus and Extended Campus credit hours are determined by the accounting code assigned to the course.
7. Undergraduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
  - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 12 credit hours
  - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 12 or more credit hours
8. Graduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
  - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 9 credit hours
  - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 9 or more credit hours
9. Race/Ethnicity Categories adhere to the reporting standards as mandated by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB). [http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg\\_notice\\_15](http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg_notice_15)
10. Race/Ethnicity is self-reported by the student. Students may leave the question blank but cannot indicate "Do not wish to provide." Non US Citizens are students with a Visa.
11. First Generation is defined as a student who reported that neither parent/guardian graduated from a four-year college.
12. Low Income is defined as a student who is Pell Grant eligible. Statistics in this report reflect those students who were offered a Pell Grant greater than zero.
13. The Graduate Unclassified classification is students who are attending but have not yet been accepted into a Master's or Doctorate program or non-degree seeking students.
14. Non-degree seeking graduate students are included in the Graduate School enrollment.
15. High School Undergraduates are enrolled students who are age 18 or younger and have not graduated high school or earned a GED.
16. New First-time students exclude high school undergraduates, Study Abroad students and, zero credit hour students. New First-Time students are those students who are enrolled in Spring as their first term.
17. New Transfer students are undergraduate students who are enrolled in Spring as their first term the undergraduate level and have earned college credit(s) at another institution.
18. Freshmen are undergraduate students who have 0-29 credits; Sophomores have 30-59 credits; Juniors have 60-89 credits, and Seniors have 90 or more credits until completion of a bachelor's degree.
19. Fall to Spring retention by classification reflects the student's class at the beginning of the fall term.

## Executive Summary

### Headcount by Classification (Page 5)

- The total university Spring Final 2014 headcount of 11,461 is down 791 students, which is a 6.5% decrease.
- Undergraduate headcount decreased 599 students (6.2%) while graduate student headcount decreased 192 students (7.4%).
- Senior classification is 33.6% of the undergraduate population compared to 31.8%.
- Graduate Doctoral headcount increased 9 students and is 23.9% of the total graduate class.
- The number of graduate Master's students decreased 60, or 4.4%. Master's students represent 55% of those at the graduate level, compared to 53% in Spring 2013.

### Credit Hours by Classification (Page 6)

- The student credit hour grand total is 133,652 a 6.5% decrease.
- The majority (84.7%) of the total student credit hours are resident (113,235); 86.6% of undergraduate credit hours and 70.6% of graduate credit hours are resident.
- Undergraduate headcount (see table Headcount by Classification, page 5) decreased 6.2%, while undergraduate credit hours decreased 6.7%.
- The graduate headcount (see table Headcount by Classification, page 5) decreased 7.4%, and the graduate Spring Final credit hours decreased 5.1%.
- The graduate Doctoral headcount (see table Headcount by Classification, page 5) increased 1.6%, and the credit hours also increased 1.6% .

### Funding Summary Headcount (Page 7)

- Main campus headcount is 85.1% of the total.
- Undergraduate WUE headcount increased 13.8%, or 66 students.
- Undergraduate headcount for students registered for extended campus courses decreased 13.9% and main campus headcount declined 5.8%.
- Graduate extended campus headcount decreased 7.5%, while main campus decreased 7.3%.

### Funding Summary Credit Hours (Page 8)

- Main campus credit hours (122,680) are 91.8% of the total 133,652. The percentage in Spring 2013 was 92.0%.
- Undergraduate main campus credit hours decreased 6.8%.
- Spring Final 2014 WUE credit hours are 6.2% of the total undergraduate credit hours.
- Graduate main campus hours decreased 5.6% compared to Spring Final 2013.
- Total main campus credit hours decreased 6.7%, while the extended campus credit hours decreased 4.3% .

### Course Load Summary (Page 9)

- Undergraduate full-time students decreased 6.5%. Graduate students who are full-time declined 5.0%.

#### **Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity (Page 12)**

- Approximately 25.5% of the undergraduate population is minority, which is an increase over Spring Final 2013 (23.2%).
- Within the minority category, the Hispanic classification is the largest and represents 16.3% of the entire undergraduate population.
- Undergraduate Multi-Racial students increased 16.6%.
- Undergraduate Asian students increased 8.6%.
- White students are 57.6% of the undergraduate population compared to 59.8% in Spring 2013.

#### **Graduate Enrollment by Ethnicity (Page 13)**

- The graduate minority population decreased 5.5% .
- Hispanic graduate students represent 7.0% of the total graduate population, increasing from 6.7% at Spring Final 2013.

#### **Undergraduate First Generation & Undergraduate Low Income (Page 14)**

- The percentage change of first generation students has remained the same as Spring Final 2013 (34%).
- Low income undergraduate students are 32.2% of all undergraduate students compared to 32.4% in Spring 2013.

#### **Undergraduate First Generation and Low Income (Page 15)**

- The percentage of undergraduate students who are both first generation and low income remained the same at 17%, compared to Spring 2013.

#### **Student Enrollment (Page 16)**

- The number of degree seeking new transfer undergraduate students decreased 18.4%.
- The number of degree seeking new first-time undergraduate students decreased 39.7%.
- Continuing non-degree seeking undergraduate students increased 13.2%.
- New first time degree seeking graduate students realized a 7.4% increase.

#### **Students Enrolled in (at least one) Online Course (Page 17)**

- The percentage of undergraduate students enrolling in at least one online course decreased from 24% in Spring 2013 to 22%.
- The percentage of graduate students enrolling in at least online course decreased from 39% to 32%.

#### **Age Summary (Page 23)**

- 86.7% of undergraduate students are under the age of 25.
- 16.0% of graduate students are 45 years old or older.

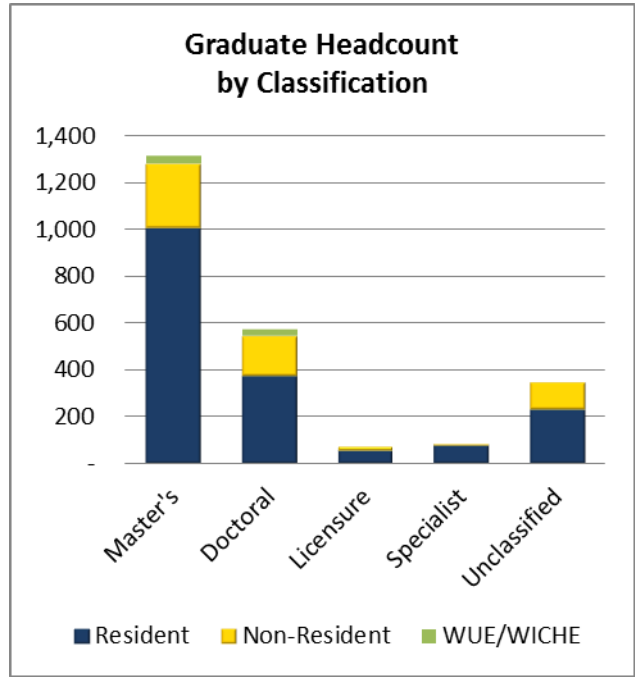
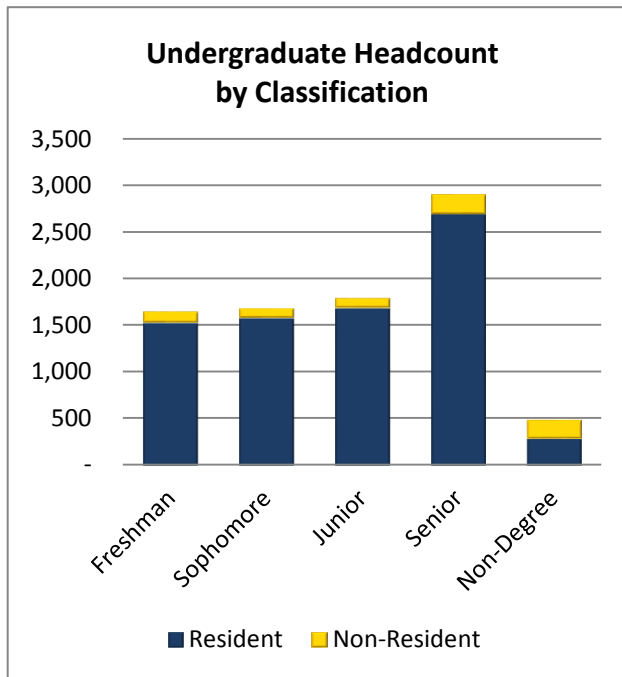
#### **Fall to Spring Undergraduate Retention (Page 24)**

**Graduate Credit Hours by Funding**



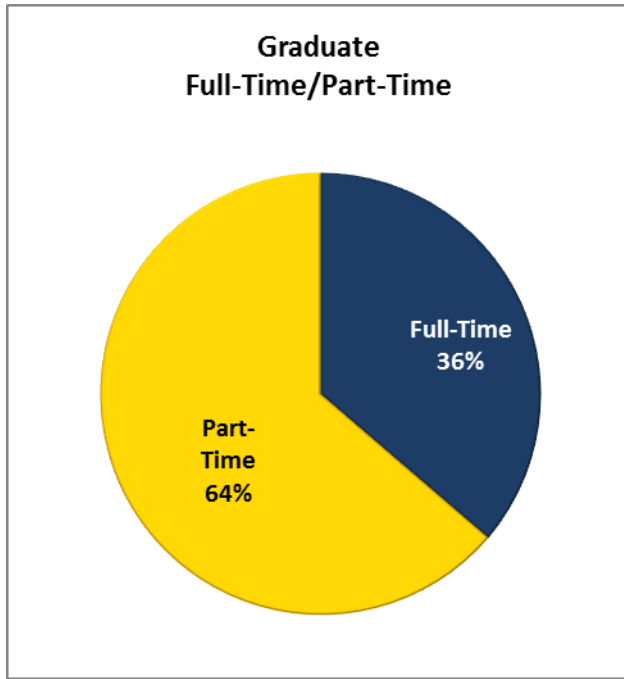
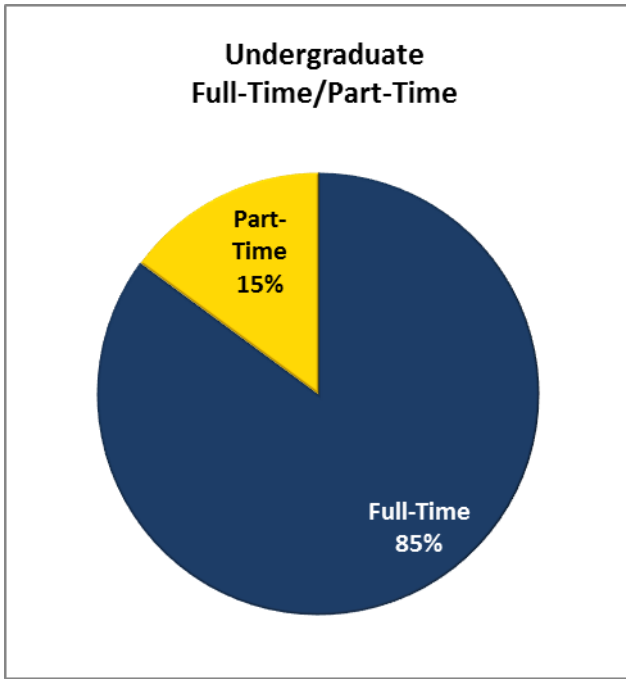
