<u>Academic Policies</u> (Newman) – No report

<u>Faculty Welfare</u> (DeKrey) – Faculty Welfare will be meeting this week. Robert Hepperle from HR will be giving a report on benefits in October. Faculty Welfare will begin working on their first item, which addresses Faculty Evaluations.

<u>Salary Equity</u> (Senbet) – The data provided by HR requires improvement, particularly concerning staff bands. There appears to be an issue with the accuracy of values in relation to NCHEM comparisons. Robert has been asked to correct the data before Senbet presents it to SEC. Although HR indicated that the bands are not useful, others rely on them for their analysis, and they are legally required. Salary bands are essential for hiring purposes, but the current data is inaccurate. Consistency in comparison with NCHEM is crucial. If the bands are incorrect, we prefer not to use them. Additionally, a request has been made for data on the roughly 60 administrative positions with available comparisons from NCHEMS51.

Standing Reports
