 - **RSCW Misconduct policy** (Faculty Welfare)
 - Senbet presented revisions to the RSCW Misconduct policy. The Faculty Welfare committee and Codification committee worked together to address concerns with the existing policy.
 - We have clarified the definitions of RSCW Misconduct based on the definitions provided by the Office of Research Integrity.
 - We have removed the mental state language because it is not crucial to determine whether misconduct happened.

- We have explicitly stated that all parties involved will be informed as to whether an inquiry will be initiated.
- We have added a new section outlining voluntary resolution, an informal resolution to the satisfaction of the Complainant(s) and Respondent(s), when allowed.
