WHEREAS, the Election Commissioner must produce and present an election timeline, outlining the spring semester's entire election process, and;

WHEREAS, the Election Commissioner has no first-hand experience about student elections like Student Senators and other elected members do;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Committee for Elections be established and governed by the following:

Section 1: Committee on Elections

- A. Statement of Purpose
 - a. To create a reasonable and realistic election timeline based on past electoral experiences and examples.
- B. Description of Membership
 - a. The Election Commissioner/Parliamentarian shall serve as the liaison and chair of the Committee for Elections.
 - b. Voting Members
 - i. Shall be composed of Senators and/or Cabinet members who are *not* seeking re-election for the following year.
 - c. Non-Voting Members
 - i. The Student Senate Advisor.
 - ii. The Chief of Staff.

C. Meetings

- a. Must be held every other week during the fall and spring semesters.
- b. The chair may hold special meetings at their discretion.

Section 2: Duration

A. This committee shall be created upon approval of the voting membership of Student Senate and shall be dissolved when the 42nd Administration is sworn into office.

Section 3: Job Description

- A. Collaborate in the creation of an election timeline.
- B. Construct a timeline based on personal and historical experiences of previous Student Senates.

Section 4: Bylaw Adherence

A. The Committee on Elections shall adhere to all bylaws outlined in Chapter III.

 - 1. Must be held at least once a month during the fall and spring semesters.
