In addition to the required courses, each major will also take 24 additional hours of electives, 200 level or above.
a. At least three credits must be taken in each of the three geographic areas (Europe, United States, Africa/ Asia/Latin America/World).
b. Of the remaining 15 hours, no more than 9 can be taken in any one of the the three geographic areas
c. At least 18 of the 24 hours must be taken from courses numbered 300 or 400 .

History majors must obtain a grade of "C-" or better in all history courses taken at UNC. Majors receiving a grade of "D+" or lower in a history course must retake the course-or an equivalent approved by the academic advisor-and receive a grade of " C " or better to receive major credit

1. All history courses numbered 300 or higher include a research and writing component.
2. Only 6 hours of HIST prefixes may be counted toward the LAC.
3. History majors must complete a minor of at least 18 semester hours, or a second major, preferably within the College of Humanities and Social Sciences.
4. The study of foreign language is recommended for those majors who plan to pursue graduate study in history.
