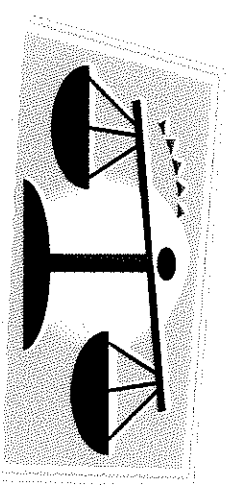
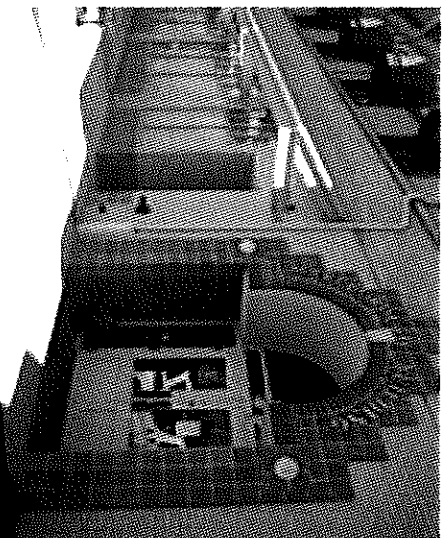
- Become a Deputy Probation Officer.

Deputy Probation Officer

The Deputy Probation Officer program allows volunteers to work one-on-one with adult and juvenile offenders in a variety of probation services. These volunteer positions offer an excellent opportunity for citizens that are interested in exploring a career in the Criminal Justice System and/or those wanting to make a difference in the community.

Deputy Probation Officers may supervise adult or juvenile probationers who have been granted probation supervision to ensure Court ordered compliance and community safety.

Specific duties may include but are not limited to meeting with adult and juvenile probationers, staffing cases and writing motions and reports to the court. Completing risk/needs assessments, alcohol evaluations and case plans along with making referrals to treatment agencies are among the many duties of being a Probation Officer.

Interns/volunteers can gain exposure to probation special programs such as Drug Court, DUI Court, Female Offender program and Intensive Supervised Probation
