Explanation of Enrollment Data

- 1. The Fall Census date was September 9, 2024. Data included in this report is information captured from the Banner Operational Data System (ODS).
- 2. Percent Change in this report is the measure of change from Fall Census 2023 to Fall Census 2024 as a percentage. Caution: When considering % change, it is important to note that increases or decreases in categories with low numbers will result in a high percentage change.
- 3. Due to rounding, some graphs may not total 100%.
- 4. Urban Education students are included in Main Campus.
- 5. Colorado School of Public Health students are not included in this summary.
- 6. Students with unknown residency are counted as non-resident.
- 7. Funding Summary:
 - a. Headcount: Students counted in Extended Campus have only cash funded courses
 - b. Credit Hours: Main Campus and Extended Campus credit hours are determined by the accounting code assigned to the course.
- 8. Undergraduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
 - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 12 credit hours
 - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 12 or more credit hours
- 9. Graduate definition of Part-Time and Full-Time students:
 - a. Part-Time: students enrolled for fewer than 9 credit hours
 - b. Full-Time: students enrolled for 9 or more credit hours
- 10. Race/Ethnicity Categories adhere to the reporting standards as mandated by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB). http://www.whitehouse.gov/omb/fedreg notice 15
- 11. Race/Ethnicity is self-reported by the student. Students may leave the question blank but cannot indicate "Do not wish to provide." Temporary US Residents are students with a Visa (other than resident aliens, refugees, asylees, and permanent residents).
- 12. First Generation is defined as a student who reported that neither parent/guardian graduated from a four-year college.
- 13. Low Income is defined as a student who is Pell Grant eligible. Statistics in this report reflect those students who were offered a Pell Grant greater than zero.
- 14. Non-degree seeking graduate students are included in the Graduate School enrollment.
- 15. High School Undergraduates are enrolled students who are age 18 or younger and have not graduated high school or earned a GED.
- 16. New First-time students exclude high school undergraduates, Study Abroad students and, zero credit hour students. New First-Time students are those students who are enrolled in Fall as their first term.
- 17. New Transfer students are undergraduate students who are enrolled in Fall as their first term the undergraduate level and have earned college credit(s) at another institution.
- 18. Freshmen are undergraduate students who have 0-29 credits; Sophomores have 30-59 credits; Juniors have 60-89 credits, and Seniors have 90 or more credits until completion of a bachelor's degree.
- 19. Fall to Fall retention by classification reflects the student's class at the beginning of the fall term.
- 20. In Fall 2019, there was the completion of a restructuring where University College was eliminated and its programs were moved to other colleges. Exploring the liberal arts (XLA) programs and student designed majors are now in Undergraduate Studies.
- 21. In Fall 2023, dual enrollment/concurrent courses were moved to state funded (Main Campus) instead of cash funded (Extended Campus).
