- 1) Discuss your long-term career aspirations and explain why these goals are meaningful to you beyond financial or career success. What personal values, past experiences, and/or community needs drive your vision of the future and help you persist through challenges?
- 2) McNair requires a major commitment of time and effort. The program is designed to challenge you, and we offer many resources and guidance to help you. What specific aspects of the McNair research and graduate school preparation experience are you most excited about?
- 3) If given the opportunity to create a project or design a research study with unlimited resources, describe what it would be, who it would impact, and what meaningful change you hope it would bring. What kinds of research questions intrigue you?
