UNC Student Senate 21-03 | BEAR Initiative

WHEREAS, the University of Northern Colorado Student Senate strives to an equitable and just campus community and environment, and;

WHEREAS, the University of Northern Colorado Student Senate is committed to combating racism, sexism, ableism, other forms of discrimination on campus, and;

WHEREAS, the Student Senate is committed to evaluating specific colleges in their efforts to combat various forms of discrimination, and;

WHEREAS, the Student Senate, under Article IV Section 3 of the Constitution, has the power to establish or abolish standing and temporary committees by a two-thirds (%) vote, and;

WHEREAS, the Student Senate bylaws do not outline the purpose and goal of the Advocacy Team in the 2018-2019 Student Senate Bylaws;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Student Senate clarifies the role and responsibility of the Advocacy Team through the BEAR (Because Everyone Advocates Rights) Initiative which shall be governed by the following:

Section 1: Advocacy Team Committee

- A. Statement of Purpose
 - a. To evaluate and interrogate existing structures within each college for discrimination and inequitable treatment of students
 - b. To solidify student senate's role as an advocacy group for the student body
- B. Description of membership
 - a. The Student Rights Advocate shall serve as the liaison and chair of the Advocacy Committee
 - b. Voting members
 - i. Shall be comprised of one senator per college
 - c. Non-voting members
 - i. Student Rights Advocate
- C. Meetings
 - a. Will occur for each college at least once per semester
 - b. Must include the Student Rights Advocate and one senator per college
 - c. Must have at least one meeting per semester with all three Senators for each college present

In Favor: 15 Opposed: 0 Abstentions: 2 Pass	
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Student Senate Section 2: Duration

A. This committee will be created contingent upon approval of the voting membership of Student Senate and remain a part of the Student Senate Constitution.

Section 3: Job Description

- A. To identify inequities in access and treatment within the structures of each university college.
- B. To actively meet with the deans of each college and relay the awareness of these inequities.
- C. To advocate for students holding marginalized identities to ensure an equitable academic experience.
- D. To allow for the advancement of success for marginalized communities across campus.
