Summary: The Master of Accounting degree program will be discontinued and replaced with the Accounting Analytics concentration within the MBA program.

Background: The Master of Accounting is an in-person degree program that has faced declining enrollments over the past five years, which is part of a national trend in these programs. A market analysis revealed that an online program is more desirable. Thus, to make better use of resources and to meet student demand, the in-person program is being replaced by an online concentration in the Master of Business Administration.
