### **New Business**

- F2F Canvas Classroom Shell Kathy Zeller
  - o Instructional design and development at UNC
    - This Canvas shell aims to work with UNC faculty where pedagogy meets technology.
    - Instructional design is mainly for online courses, if faculty is interested in F2F shell they must submit a ticket to gain access.
      - Support will mainly be through Canvas itself instead of IM&T
    - How do we get it to Faculty? How do we lower the barriers or make things easier to use?
      - Training will be available online 24/7.
    - From a student's perspective it is easier to use/read
      - Easier for students to navigate. Easier for faculty to start up a course.
      - Kathy will reach out to SGA and set something up with them.

- Based on feedback UGC can draft a policy and send it to APC.
- UNIV New Course Proposal Mindfulness Melissa Malde
  - o Proposing new course Mindfulness Institute of Emerging Adults
    - About 10 instructors have been taught meditation and will be instructors.
    - This course will be open to both undergraduate and graduate courses.
      - 6 contact hours
      - 4 credit hours through extended campus (extended campus would be easier for instructors but there will be an overload)
      - The course will consist of in person, a retreat, and asynchronous meetings.
    - Certain criteria must be met before moving forward with addition to course catalog.
    - Will return to UGC next month after more information is received. A syllabus will be sent to members.
